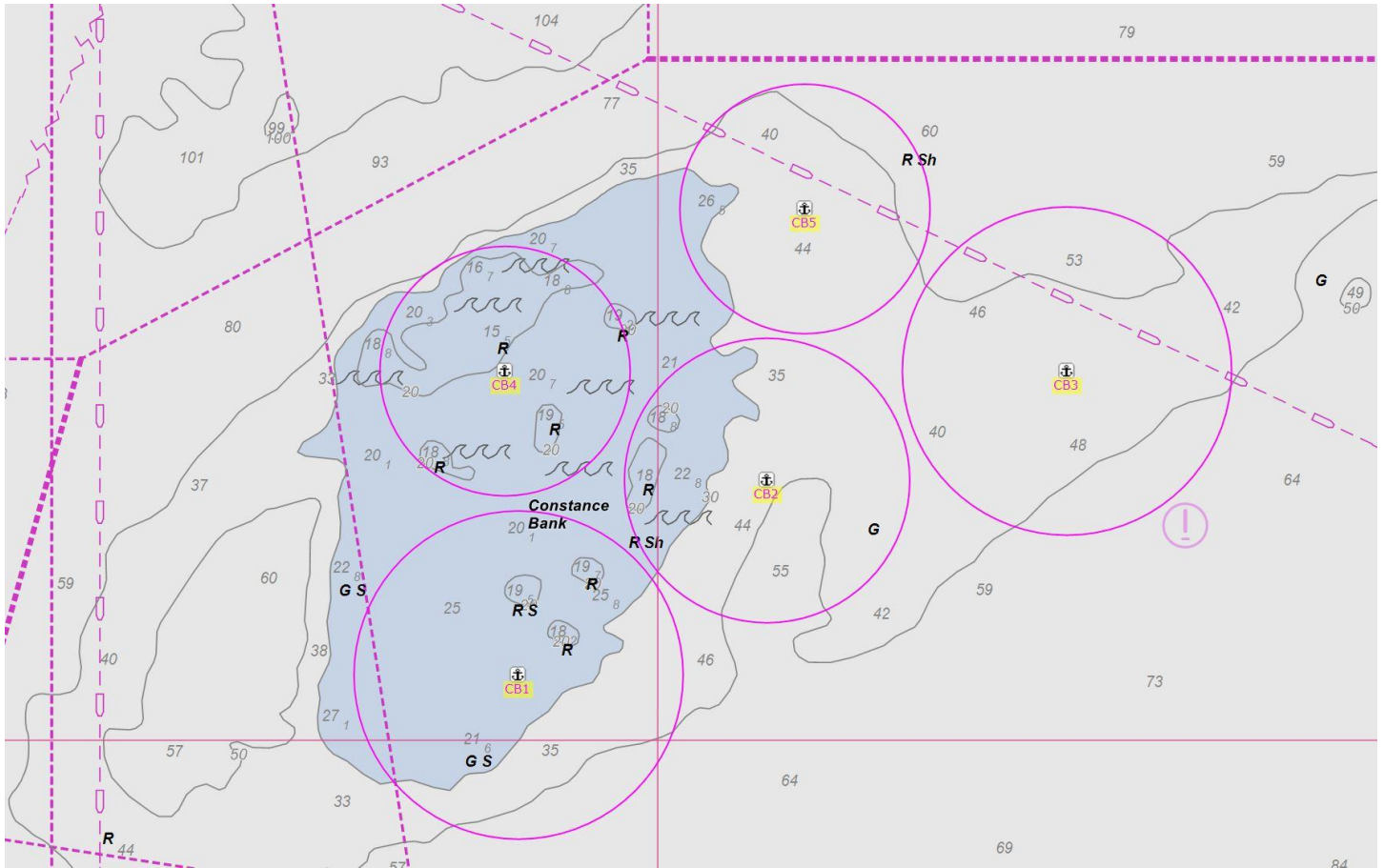


NOTICE TO INDUSTRY

- Date Issued:** 23 December 2016 (**updated 03 February 2017**) **Notice Number:** 12/2016
(replaces Notice 02/2012)
- Subject:** Constance Bank Short Term Anchorage, Off Victoria, BC
- Geographic Area:** Salish Sea, Straits of Juan de Fuca (Approaches to Victoria, BC)
- Communication:** The Authority has increased the availability of the five anchorages at Constance Bank to year-round, short-term use up to a maximum duration of 48 hours.
- Details:** The anchorages are exposed to wind, waves and swell.
The seafloor comprises of sand, gravel and rock as well as shells.
Anchorage CB3E is reserved for emergency use only.
Anchorages CB4 and CB5 are given priority for Asian Gypsy Moth inspections from 1 March – 15 September.
Mariners are referred to the relevant section in the Sailing Directions PAC 201 for additional information.
